Index (API) Base  
and State Rank

Peggy Anatol, Director of Assessment, provided an overview of the District school's Academic Performance Index (API) base and growth reports. The school's API is based on standardized testing results and the California High School Exam results as primary measures of students' academic achievement. Dr. Anatol was proud to report that District schools continue to show excellent progress on the Academic Performance Index. Seventeen schools have surpassed the State target of 800, 12 schools have improved their Academic State Rank, and 8 schools carry the Statewide Rank of 10.
