Report from Closed Session

The Board took the following actions in Closed Session relative to Student Discipline:

In a prior session, in Student Case No. 04-73-79, the Board took action to expel the student from the schools of the Newport-Mesa Unified School District for the period of 6/7/05 through 1/31/06. The student is to attend ACCESS during the period of expulsion and must maintain acceptable grades, attendance and citizenship. The student is to complete 50 hours of community service and complete at least eight counseling sessions for appropriate behavior and decision making as terms for the expulsion agreement. Motion by Mrs. Fluor, seconded by Mrs. Sneen and carried with a 6/0 vote (Franco absent).

In a prior session in Student Case No. 04-72-79, the Board took action to expel the student from the schools of the Newport-Mesa Unified School District for the period of 6/7/05 through 1/31/06 and the expulsion will be suspended from 6/24/05 through 1/31/06. The student is to attend ACCESS during the expulsion period and must maintain acceptable grades, attendance and citizenship. The student is to complete 50 hours of community service and complete at least eight counseling sessions for appropriate behavior and decision making as terms for the expulsion agreement. Motion by Mrs. Black, seconded by Mr. Brooks, and carried with a 6/0 vote (Franco absent).

The student is to complete 50 hours of community service and complete at least eight counseling sessions for drug abuse as terms for the expulsion agreement. Motion by Mrs. Fluor, seconded by Mrs. Sneen and carried with a 6/0 vote (Franco absent).

In a prior session, in Student Case No. 04-65-77, the Board took action to expel the student from the schools of the Newport-Mesa Unified School District for the period of 6/7/05 through 5/17/06. The student is to attend ACCESS during the period of expulsion and must maintain acceptable grades, attendance and citizenship. The student is to complete 50 hours of community service and complete at least eight counseling sessions for appropriate behavior and decision making as terms for the expulsion agreement. Motion by Mrs. Fluor, seconded by Mrs. Black and carried with a 6/0 vote (Franco absent).

In a prior session, in Student Case No. 04-70-77, the Board took action to expel the student from the schools of the Newport-Mesa Unified School District for the period of 6/7/05 through 5/18/06. The student is to attend ACCESS during the period of expulsion and must maintain acceptable grades, attendance and citizenship. The student is to complete 50 hours of community service and complete at least eight counseling sessions for drug abuse as terms for the expulsion agreement. Motion by Mrs. Fluor, seconded by Mr. Brooks and carried with a 6/0 vote (Franco absent).
