

# Hands-on Applied Behavior Analysis workshop

- Understand that upon completing and passing the written and observation evaluation following the training you may be reassigned to an ABA aide position, which includes a pay increase by 7.5 %. This would result in a reassignment to an autism classroom and/or ABA program.
